

**Record of Proceedings
Coshocton City Council
Meeting Held: January 11, 2016**

The regular session of the Coshocton City Council was called to order at 7:00 pm by Council President Cliff Biggers, Council Members present were Mr. Bob Fetters, Mr. Jim Baker, Ms. Jackie Salmans, Mr. Brad Fuller and Mr. Glenn Mishler. Jim Baker made a motion to excuse Tom Grier, seconded by Bob Fetters. All members voted yes. Also present Mr. Steve Mercer, Mayor; Mr. Jerry Stenner, Safety Service Director and Ms. Cherry Wilson, Clerk.




