

**Record of Proceedings
Coshocton City Council
Meeting Held: October 11, 2016**

The regular session of the Coshocton City Council was called to order at 7:00 pm by Council President Cliff Biggers, Council Members present were Mr. Bob Fetters, Mr. Jim Baker, Ms. Jackie Salmans, Mr. Roger Moore, Mr. Tom Grier and Mr. Glenn Mishler. Glenn Mishler made a motion to excuse Mr. Brad Fuller, seconded by Jackie Salmans, all members voted yes. Also present Mr. Steve Mercer, Mayor; Safety Service Director, Jerry Stenner and Ms. Cherry Wilson, Clerk.

Previous Meeting Minutes: President Biggers confirmed that all council members had received the minutes from September 26th. Tom Grier made the motion to accept the minutes as presented seconded by Bob Fetters. After a roll call vote all members voted yes.

Petitions & Remonstrance's: Richard Emler of Park Avenue spoke to council about Bancroft Park. His biggest concern was he wanted to make sure there was a bench inside the bus stop for the children to sit on and he had questions regarding the pricing of the playground equipment. Mayor Mercer addressed his questions and concerns.


