

**Record of Proceedings  
Coshocton City Council  
Meeting Held: October 24, 2016**

The regular session of the Coshocton City Council was called to order at 7:00 pm by Council President Cliff Biggers, Council Members present were Mr. Bob Fetters, Mr. Jim Baker, Ms. Jackie Salmans, Mr. Brad Fuller, Mr. Roger Moore, Mr. Tom Grier and Mr. Glenn Mishler. Also present Mr. Steve Mercer, Mayor; Safety Service Director, Jerry Stenner and Ms. Cherry Wilson, Clerk.

**Previous Meeting Minutes:** President Biggers confirmed that all council members had received the minutes from 10/11/16. Jackie Salmans made the motion to accept the minutes as presented seconded by Glenn Mishler. After a roll call vote all members voted yes.

**Petitions & Remonstrance's:** Tina Dobson of Hillsdale Drive addressed council concerning getting water ran to her street, she has asked several times. She polled 11 of her neighbors and 7 said yes others had questions regarding cost but none said no. She said everyone in her neighborhood has problems with their water. Mayor Mercer told Ms. Dobson her street has always been at the top of the list when considering expansion of water lines.

**Introduction of Ordinances:** Glenn Mishler made the motion to add Resolutions 7-16 and 8-16 to the Agenda, seconded by Bob Fetters, all members voted yes.

**Legislation at first reading:**

44-16 an ordinance authorizing the mayor or service director to enter into an Amendment of Lease Agreement with Kids America, Inc and the Landlord's Release and Consent Agreement. After some discussion Jackie Salmans made a motion to suspend the rules and give the

ordinance a second reading, seconded by Roger Moore 6 members voted yes with Tom Grier voting no. After the second reading Jackie Salmans made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a third reading, seconded by Brad Fuller, 6 members voted yes with Tom Grier voting no. After the third reading, 6 members voted yes, with Tom Grier voting no. Ordinance 44-16 passed with emergency clause.

45-16 a new ordinance to supercede any previous ordinances regarding income tax distribution. Ordinance to take its course.

46-16 transfers. Tom Grier made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a second reading, seconded by Glenn Mishler, all members voted yes. After the second reading Jackie Salmans made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a third reading, seconded by Roger Moore, all members voted yes. After the third reading, all members voted yes. Ordinance 46-16 passed with emergency clause.

47-16 appropriations. Tom Grier made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a second reading, seconded by Brad Fuller, all members voted yes. After the second reading Jackie Salmans made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a third reading, seconded by Roger Moore, all members voted yes. After the third reading, all members voted yes. Ordinance 47-16 passed with emergency clause.

All members voted yes. Resolution 8-16 was adopted.


