

**Record of Proceedings
Coshocton City Council
Meeting Held: October 27, 2014**

The regular session of the Coshocton City Council was called to order at 7:00 pm by Council President Cliff Biggers, Council Members present were: Mr. Bob Feters, Mr. Jim Baker, Ms. Jackie Salmans, Mr. Brad Fuller, Mr. Bob Pell, Mr. Cliff Biggers, Mr. Tom Grier and Mr. Glenn Mishler. 

Unfinished Business: None


New Business: President Biggers asked council about moving committee meetings back to the conference room where it is a less formal atmosphere. No one objected.
