

**Record of Proceedings
Coshocton City Council
Meeting Held: February 10, 2014**

The regular session of the Coshocton City Council was called to order at 7:00 pm by Council President Cliff Biggers, Council Members present were: Mr. Bob Fetters, Mr. Jim Baker, Mrs. Jackie Salmans, Mr. Brad Fuller, Mr. Bob Pell, Mr. Cliff Biggers, and Mr. Glenn Mishler. Also present Mr. Steve Mercer, Mayor; Mr. Jerry Stenner, Safety Service Director and Ms. Cherry Wilson, Clerk. Absent was Mr. Tom Grier, Jackie Salmans made the motion to excuse Mr. Grier, seconded by Bob Fetters, all members voted yes.

Previous Meeting Minutes: President Biggers confirmed that all council members had received the minutes from January 27th. Brad Fuller made a motion to accept the minutes as submitted, seconded by Glenn Mishler. After a roll call vote all members voted yes.

City Officers Report:

Mayor's Report: Mayor Mercer went over his monthly report. He introduced Kevin Sharier as the Assistant Public Works Director and commented Kevin is skilled in a variety of machinery that is used in the street and cemetery departments. The Mayor thanked Kevin for accepting the position and noted it seems to be working out well.

Service Director's Report: Mr. Stenner said he echoed Mayor Mercer's thoughts and he added that those two guys have been spending their whole nights out trying to make the streets safe for our citizens. He said they work with a limited crew and the workers are split up to go 12 hour shifts during storms. Mr. Stenner stated the crew has rallied around Jim and Kevin and done whatever it took to get the job done. He said Jim Ruby is trying to plan how to get more salt if needed.

Law Director's Report: Mr. Bob Skelton presented his January Report to council.

Sheriff's Office Report: Sheriff Rogers was present with no report.

Public Works Department Report: Public Works Director Jim Ruby and Assistant Public Works Director Kevin Sharier were both present. Mr. Ruby said 22 tons of cold mix has been used and the department has spent approximately \$16,500 in overtime, \$35,000 has been spent in salt and we will probably need at least \$25,000 more in salt. Salt was selling for \$48.84 per ton it is now \$116.00 per ton. Jim said luckily Jerry Stenner warned him about the salt and they started using it more sparingly. His department tries to maintain traffic during snow storms and then tries to clean up as quickly as possible. He asked for patience from the community the snow has to be plowed somewhere, it is plowed from street to street and has to go somewhere. He has an upcoming meeting with Ohio Department of Natural Resources regarding mine seepage, not in just one area of the city but all over the city.




Unfinished Business: None
