

**Record of Proceedings  
Coshocton City Council  
Meeting Held: March 14, 2016**

The regular session of the Coshocton City Council was called to order at 7:00 pm by Council President Cliff Biggers, Council Members present were Mr. Bob Fetters, Mr. Jim Baker, Ms. Jackie Salmans, Mr. Brad Fuller, Mr. Roger Moore, Mr. Tom Grier and Mr. Glenn Mishler. Also present Mr. Steve Mercer, Mayor; Mr. Jerry Stenner, Safety Service Director and Ms. Cherry Wilson, Clerk.

**Previous Meeting Minutes:** President Biggers confirmed that all council members had received the minutes from February 22 and February 29 (special meeting). Tom Grier made the motion to accept the minutes as presented, seconded by Jackie Salmans. After a roll call vote all members voted yes.

**Petitions & Remonstrance's:** Several residents were present to express their objections to changing trash companies and/or using the wheeled totes. Both Kimble Company and Waste Management Company were present and made short presentations.

Mayor's Report: Mayor Mercer started by explaining the choice was never which hauler to use or the level of service it was about a method that was desired. He stated he did not think the carts would make the city pristine, there will still be trash but this would help clean up a lot of problems where animals and winds scatter trash everywhere. This method would furnish everyone with a lidded container. The Mayor also went over his monthly report that was included in council packets.

**Introduction of Ordinances:**

**Legislation at first reading:**

9-16 an ordinance authorizing the mayor or service director to sign the Community Block Grant Program (CDBG) participation agreement with the County of Coshocton. Ordinance to take its course.

10-16 an ordinance amending ordinance 33-15 and 59-15 establishing wages for those positions that are exempt from collective bargaining. Tom Grier made a motion to remove ordinance from Agenda, seconded by Glenn Mishler. All members voted yes.

11-16 an ordinance establishing trash rates and authorizing the mayor or service director to accept the bid and sign an agreement with Kimble Companies. Ordinance to take its course.

12-16 appropriations. Tom Grier made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a second reading, seconded by Glenn Mishler, all members voted yes. After the second reading Glenn Mishler made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a third reading, seconded by Jackie Salmans, all members voted yes. After the third reading all members voted yes. Ordinance 12-16 passed.

**Legislation at second reading:**

**Legislation at third reading:**

2-16 an ordinance to amend Chapters 1305, 1351 and 979 of the City of Coshocton's Codified Ordinances. After the third reading all members voted yes. Ordinance 2-16 passed.

4-16 an ordinance authorizing the Mayor or Service Director to prepare specifications, advertise and let a bid for Chlorine, Fluoride, Alum, Lime, CO2, Sodium Hexametaphosphate and Gasoline. After the third reading all members voted yes. Ordinance 4-16 passed.

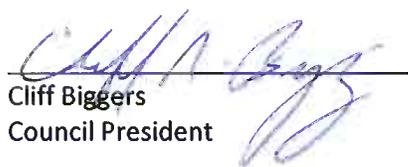
