

**Record of Proceedings
Coshocton City Council
Meeting Held: March 24, 2014**

After the first reading Bob Fetters made the motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a second reading seconded by Tom Grier, all members voted yes. After the second reading Tom Grier made the motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a third reading seconded by Bob Pell, all members voted yes. After the third reading all members voted yes. Ordinance 10-14 passed with the emergency clause.


Unfinished Business: None


