

**Record of Proceedings
Coshocton City Council
Meeting Held: April 13, 2015**

6:45 Public Hearing for PC 1-15, zoning change for 925 Cambridge Road. No public attended, meeting closed at 7:00 pm.

The regular session of the Coshocton City Council was called to order at 7:00 pm by Council President Cliff Biggers, Council Members present were: Mr. Bob Fetters, Mr. Jim Baker, Mr. Brad Fuller, Ms. Jackie Salmans, Mr. Tom Grier, Mr. Bob Pell and Mr. Glenn Mishler. Also present Mr. Steve Mercer, Mayor; Mr. Jerry Stenner, Safety Service Director and Ms. Cherry Wilson, Clerk.

Previous Meeting Minutes: President Biggers confirmed that all council members had received the minutes from March 23, 2015. Tom Grier made the motion to accept the minutes as submitted seconded by Glenn Mishler. After a roll call vote all members voted yes.

Petitions & Remonstrance's: Jim McClure of Zero Street a member of the Safe Coshocton Committee said he is asked often what it will mean if the levy for the Income Tax Rate Change does not pass. He said he would like to know how council would answer this question. After a discussion with many participants the general consensus was some version of the levy would be placed back on the ballot in November. Ultimately if it does not pass the result will be a reduction in services the Sheriff's Office currently provides for the residents of the city.

5-15 Otsego Avenue Rehabilitation. After a roll call vote, all members voted yes. Resolution 5-15 was adopted.




