**Legislation at first reading:**

After the second reading Jackie Salmans made the motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a third reading seconded by Brad Fuller. After the third reading all members voted yes. Ordinance 19-13 passed with the emergency clause.

20-13 an ordinance authorizing the Mayor, Service Director and/or City Auditor to borrow the funds necessary for the paving of Chestnut Street located in the City of Coshocton State of Ohio. After the first reading Tom Edwards made the motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a second reading seconded by Tom Grier. After the second reading Tom Grier made the motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a third reading seconded by Bob Fetters.

After the third reading all members voted yes. Ordinance 20-13 passed with the emergency clause.

**Resolutions:**


