

**Record of Proceedings  
Coshocton City Council  
Meeting Held: April 27, 2015**

The regular session of the Coshocton City Council was called to order at 7:00 pm by Council President Cliff Biggers, Council Members present were: Mr. Bob Fetters, Mr. Jim Baker, Mr. Brad Fuller, Ms. Jackie Salmans, Mr. Tom Grier and Mr. Bob Pell. Bob Fetters made the motion to excuse Mr. Glenn Mishler, seconded by Tom Grier, all members voted yes.. Also present Mr. Steve Mercer, Mayor; Mr. Jerry Stenner, Safety Service Director and Ms. Cherry Wilson, Clerk.

**Previous Meeting Minutes:** President Biggers confirmed that all council members had received the minutes from April 13, 2015. Tom Grier made the motion to accept the minutes as submitted seconded by Jim Baker. After a roll call vote all members voted yes.

**Legislation at first reading:**

After the second reading Brad Fuller made the motion to give the ordinance a third reading, seconded by Bob Pell, all members voted yes. After the third reading all members voted yes. Ordinance 14-15 passed with the emergency clause.

15-15 an ordinance authorizing the mayor to sign the Coshocton County, City of Coshocton Water and Sanitary Sewer System. Ordinance to take its course.

**Legislation at second reading:**

10-15 an ordinance authorizing the mayor or service director to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) to participate in their contract(s) for Sodium Chloride (road salt) for the 2015-2016 season. Ordinance to take its course.

11-15 an ordinance authorizing the mayor or service director to enter into an agreement to lease an office space to the state department of health. Glenn Mishler made the motion to amend the ordinance to the rate of \$350.00 (clerical error), seconded by Tom Grier, all members voted yes. Ordinance to take its course.

12-15 an ordinance to amend ordinance 16-13 extending the pay rates for all non-bargaining unit employees until the last pay of September 2015. Ordinance to take its course.

13-15 an ordinance to amend the zoning map of the City of Coshocton. Ordinance to take its course.


**Unfinished Business:** None


**New Business:** None
