

**Record of Proceedings
Coshocton City Council
Meeting Held: May, 28, 2013**

The regular session of the Coshocton City Council was called to order at 7:00 pm by Council President Cliff Biggers, Council Members present were: Mr. Bob Fetters, Mr. Jim Baker, Mr. Brad Fuller, Mr. Tom Edwards, Mr. Cliff Biggers, Mr. Tom Grier and Mr. Glenn Mishler. Also present Mr. Steve Mercer, Mayor; Jerry Stenner, Safety Service Director and Ms. Cherry Wilson, Clerk. Bob Fetters made the motion to excuse councilwoman Jackie Salmans, seconded by Jim Baker. All members voted yes.

Previous Meeting Minutes: President Biggers confirmed that all council members had received the minutes from May 13th. Tom Grier made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, seconded by Glenn Mishler. After a roll call vote all members voted yes.

Petitions & Remonstrance's: Dick Stoker 1531 Arrowhead Drive stated he was in support of any taxation to support street repair. Mr. Stoker asked several questions regarding the paving done on South 14th last year. He had concerns that the pavement is already has several severe cracks. Mr. Stenner told Mr. Stoker he and the Public Works Director, Jim Ruby would go inspect the street Wednesday, and call the paving company if repairs were necessary or they felt the job had not been done properly. Mary Smith of 420 North 12th Street asked council if a decision had been made on her pot belly pig. Mrs. Smith presented council with the doctor's recommendation that Harley is a therapeutic pet for her and her daughter. She also had papers from a veterinarian who came to her home to do an evaluation on Harley. Mr. Baker informed her that his committee would make a recommendation to council at the next committee meeting on June 3rd.

Mr. Stenner explained both jobs were bid out and awarded to the lowest bidder. The work was done by 2 different companies. Again Mr. Stenner said he would contact the paver if he finds the job was not done correctly. Mr. Stenner also said the street department is out filling holes and striping the streets. He also reminded everyone mowing issues must go through the health department first. Once deemed a health hazard they are turned over to the street department to be mowed.


Unfinished Business: None
