Coshocton City Council
Meeting Held: June 13, 2016**

6:45 Public Hearing for the City of Coshocton budget for fiscal year 2017. No public participation.

The regular session of the Coshocton City Council was called to order at 7:00 pm by Council President Cliff Biggers, Council Members present were Mr. Bob Fetters, Mr. Jim Baker, Ms. Jackie Salmans, Mr. Brad Fuller, Mr. Roger Moore, Mr. Tom Grier and Mr. Glenn Mishler. Previous Meeting Minutes: President Biggers confirmed that all council members had received the minutes from May 23rd. Glenn Mishler made the motion to accept the minutes as presented seconded by Roger Moore. After a roll call vote all members voted yes.

Introduction of Ordinances:

Legislation at first reading:

24-16 Appropriations. After the first reading, Tom Grier made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a second reading, seconded by Jackie Salmans, all members voted yes. After the second reading, Glenn Mishler made a motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a third reading, seconded by Roger Moore, all members voted yes. After the third reading all members voted yes. Ordinance 24-16 passed with emergency clause.

25-16 an ordinance adopting the budget of the City of Coshocton, Ohio for the fiscal year beginning January 2017, and submitting same to the County Auditor. Ordinance to take its course.

Legislation at second reading:

21-16 an ordinance to establish regulations of towers in the City of Coshocton. Ordinance to take its course.

20-16 appropriations. Ordinance to take its course.

Legislation at third reading:

19-16 an ordinance authorizing the Mayor or Service Director to sign a grant application for the Transportation Alternatives Program with the Ohio Department of Transportation for the SR16-SR541 Overpass and Three Rivers Bridge Enhancements. All members voted yes. Ordinance 19-16 passed.


