

**Record of Proceedings  
Coshocton City Council  
Meeting Held: June 27, 2016**

The regular session of the Coshocton City Council was called to order at 7:00 pm by Council President Cliff Biggers, Council Members present were Mr. Bob Fetters, Mr. Jim Baker, Ms. Jackie Salmans, Mr. Brad Fuller, Mr. Roger Moore and Mr. Glenn Mishler. Absent was Mr. Tom Grier, Jackie Salmans made a motion to excuse Tom Grier, seconded by Glenn Mishler, all members voted yes. Also present Mr. Steve Mercer, Mayor; Safety Service Director, Jerry Stenner and Ms. Cherry Wilson, Clerk.

**Previous Meeting Minutes:** President Biggers confirmed that all council members had received the minutes from June 13<sup>th</sup>. Glenn Mishler made the motion to accept the minutes as presented seconded by Bob Fetters. After a roll call vote all members voted yes.

Mayor's Report: Mayor Mercer announced the fireworks celebration for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July will be done on Sunday the 3<sup>rd</sup> at the Coshocton Airport. The road will be turned into a one way after the show in order to make leaving easier and faster for everyone. Bob Brems is on the committee agenda July 5<sup>th</sup> he is bringing in the Public Health Deputy Commissioner from Hancock County to make a presentation regarding merging of city and county health departments. Hancock County and Findlay have merged their two health departments. The Mayor also announced he hired Jon Cotterman for the Property Code Investigator position, he will start July 5<sup>th</sup>. "I am grateful to have him with his skills and mindset."

Service Director's Report: Jerry Stenner reported Otsego Avenue draining work will be finished before the milling and paving will be done, we are also working with Ohio Central Railroad to remove the tracks. Paving is estimated to begin early August. Highland Blvd, Fairview, Orchard and 12<sup>th</sup> Streets paving should begin late July, early August. All potholes should be filled by the end of this week.
