

**Record of Proceedings  
Coshocton City Council  
Meeting Held: July 27, 2015**

The regular session of the Coshocton City Council was called to order at 7:00 pm by Council President Cliff Biggers, Council Members present were: Mr. Bob Fetters, Mr. Jim Baker, Ms. Jackie Salmans, Mr. Brad Fuller, Mr. Bob Pell, Mr. Tom Grier and Mr. Glenn Mishler. Also present Mr. Jerry Stenner, Safety Service Director and Ms. Cherry Wilson, Clerk.

**Previous Meeting Minutes:** President Biggers confirmed that all council members had received the minutes from July 13, 2015. Tom Grier made the motion to accept the minutes as presented seconded by Jackie Salmans. After a roll call vote all members voted yes.

**Petitions & Remonstrance's:** All council member announced they would recognize Coshocton is Blooming yard nominations after recess.

Mayor Mercer opened the floor for council members to recognize Coshocton is Blooming yard nominations. This program is to recognize business and homes in Coshocton that have exceeded normal maintenance and have added plants/flowers/décor to make their yards stand out in their neighborhoods.

**Introduction of Ordinances:**

**Legislation at first reading:**

31-15 appropriations. After the first reading, Tom Grier made the motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a second reading, seconded by Bob Pell, all members voted yes. After the second reading Jackie Salmans made the motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a third reading, seconded by Jim Baker, all members voted yes. After the third reading all members voted yes. Ordinance 31-15 passed with the emergency clause.

32-15 an ordinance to establish the honorary street name Sky Wharton Way on Water Street from Main Street to Mulberry Street. After the first reading, Brad Fuller made the motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a second reading, seconded by Tom Grier, all members voted yes. After the second reading Bob Pell made the motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a third reading, seconded by Tom Grier, all members voted yes. After the third reading all members voted yes. Ordinance 32-15 passed with the emergency clause.

33-15 an ordinance establishing wages for those positions that are exempt from collective bargaining. After much discussion the ordinance is to take its course.

34-15 an ordinance to amend the City of Coshocton Personnel Policy Manual. Ordinance to take its course.

Brad Fuller made the motion to add ordinance 30-15 and resolution 5-15 to the agenda, seconded by Glenn Mishler, all members voted yes.

30-15 an ordinance authorizing the mayor or service director to enter into a contract through the State of Ohio Public Works Commission with Geostabilization International, Inc of Grand Junction, Co. for the procurement and installation of supernails® and other components of a project identified as Cambridge Road (State Route 541) Emergency Slip Project. After the first reading, Brad Fuller made the motion to suspend the rules and give the ordinance a second reading, seconded by Tom Grier, all members voted yes. After the second reading Jackie Salmans made the motion to give the ordinance a third reading, seconded by Jim Baker, all members voted yes. After the third reading all members voted yes. Ordinance 30-15 passed with the emergency clause.

**New Business:** A special council meeting was scheduled for Monday, August 3, at 5:00 pm.


**Communications:** None
