27-24 AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COSHOCTON, OHIO, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 2025, AND SUBMITTING SAME TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR. Chad Johnson made a motion to suspend the rules and give the Ordinance a second and third reading, seconded by Roger Moore. After a roll call all members voted yes.

24-24 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF COSHOCTON TO ENTER INTO AN ENTERPRISE ZONE AGREEMENT WITH MFM BUILDING PRODUCTS CORPORATION, PURSUANT TO SECTION 5709.63 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE; AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF COSHOCTON TO ENTER INTO A RELATED SCHOOL COMPENSATION AGREEMENT WITH THE RIVER VIEW LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT REGARDING SAME; AND SUBMITTING NOTICE TO THE DIRECTOR OF DEVELOPMENT OF THE STATE OF OHIO. 
